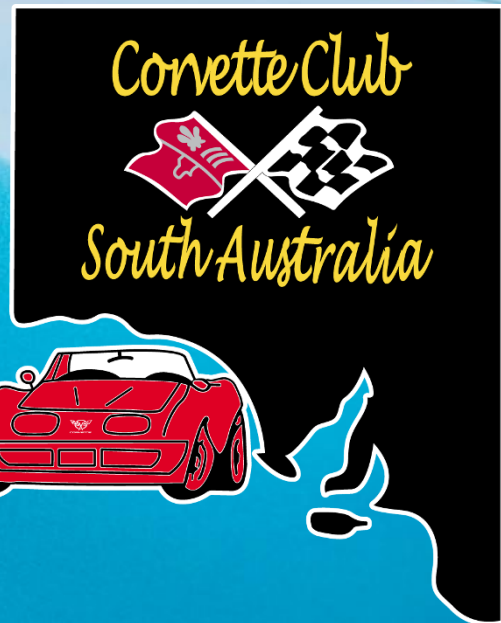

Peter then sought clarification if we had to have a Special Meeting. CBS advised we do not need a special meeting as it is a requirement under the Act.

Please see below the additions to our constitution in red as required by CBS:

### **3 MEMBERSHIP OF THE ASSOCIATION**

A person may join the Association, by completing an application for membership available from the Membership Officer at a meeting, (contact via Mobile or email and requesting a form) or by completing a form online on the Club web site and submitting for approval.

#### **3.1 Membership Rules**

g) A register of members must be kept and contain:

- i. The name and address of each member
- ii. The email address of each member
- iii. The phone number of each member
- iv. The date on which each member was admitted to, or resigned from, the Association
- v. The date of and reason (s) for termination

### **7 GOVERNMENT OF THE ASSOCIATION**

a) The governing body of the Association shall be the elected Committee and the said Committee shall be elected to office at a duly convened Annual General Meeting.

b) The Elected Executive Committee and Committee has the management and control of the funds and other property of the Association.

c) The Committee of the Association will comprise of the following positions:

#### **7.2 Committee:**

f) The Committee shall be advised of the date and location of the meeting at least 3 (three) working days prior to the meeting by email from The Secretary.

g) At least fifty percent (50%) of the Executive Committee and fifty percent (50%) of the Committee being present shall form a quorum.

### **12 AMENDMENT OF THE RULES**

The Constitution may be added to, repealed or amended at any Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting at which notice of such intention had been given to Members at least Fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting. A resolution from such a purpose shall require

a Quorum of Ten (10) Percent of financial Members with voting rights voting thereon.

a) If there is any inconsistency between the Rules or by-laws and the Act, the Act prevails.

The letter confirmed we did not require a Special meeting to vote as it is requirements of the Act and the Constitution was sealed and registered.

(Yes there's a story there)

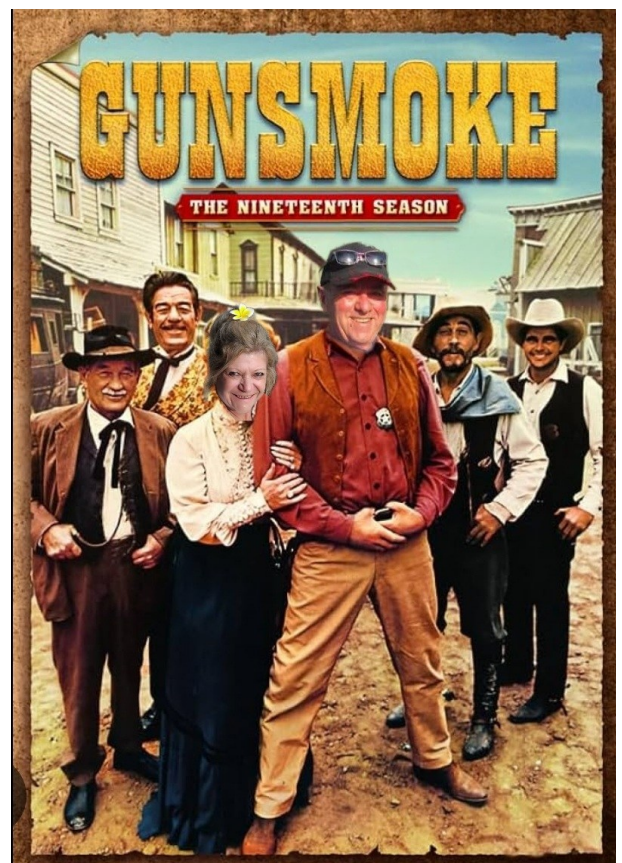
The Myponga Pistol club are a very welcoming group and did a great job of looking after us . We are welcome back anytime and maybe if members want to we can make it an annual event .

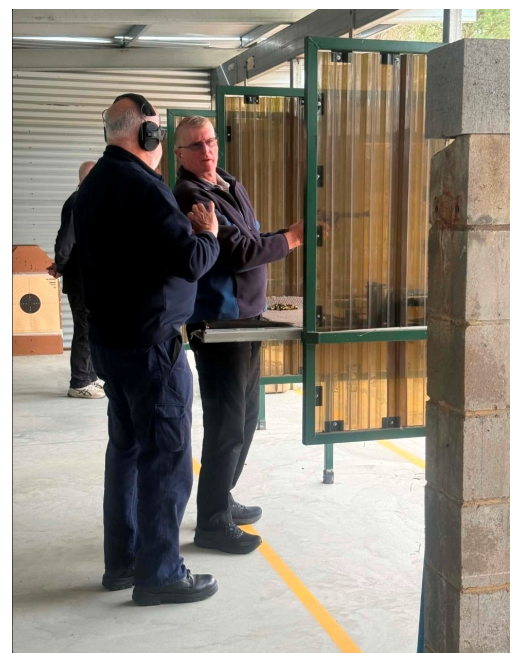
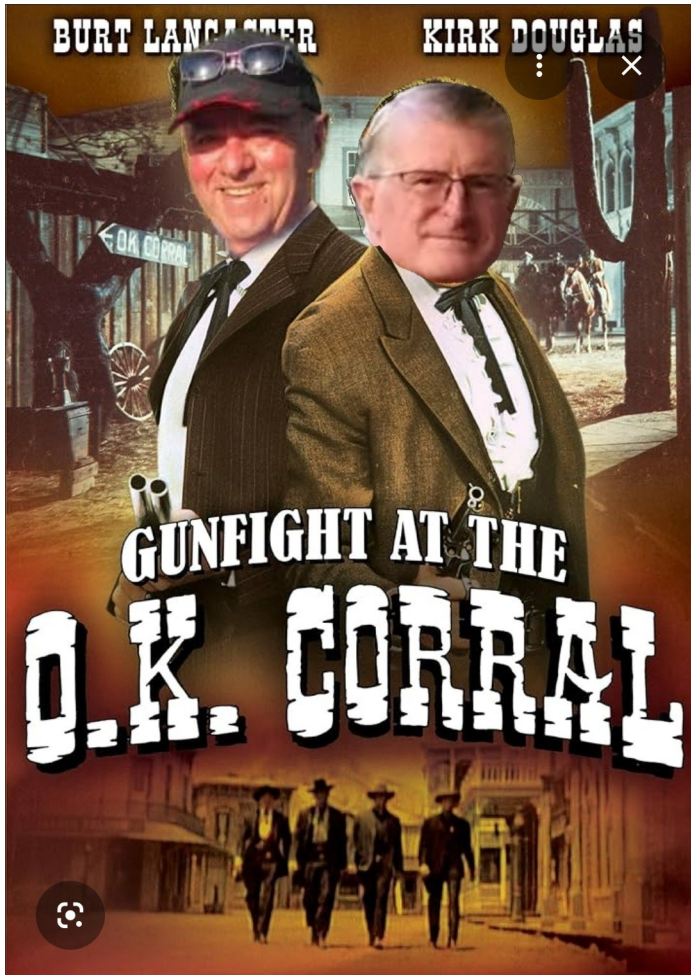
The day ended with some leaving sooner than others but most of us stayed back and shared a beer with our hosts before firing up our chariots and heading off into the distance down the Lawless road .

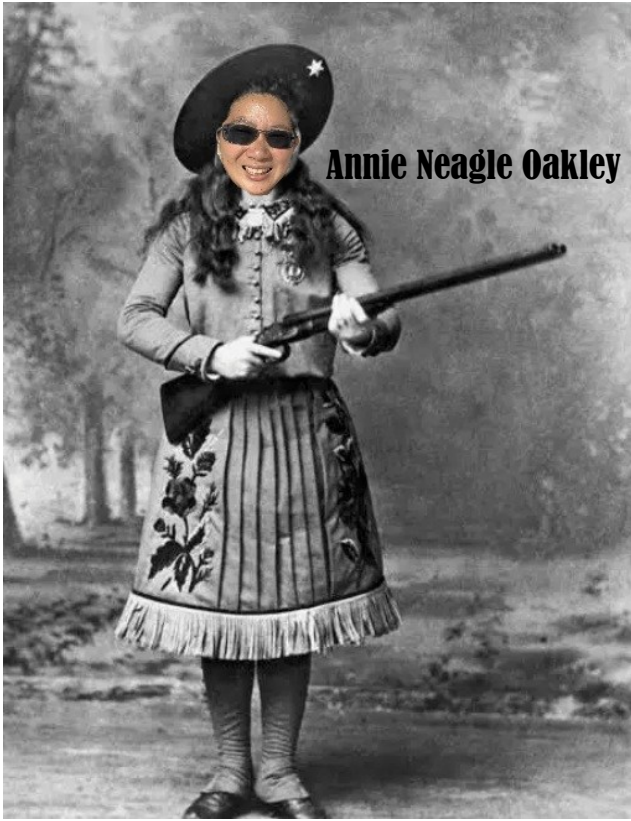
