












### **IMPORTANT:** Membership Information Update

## Corvette ZR1X

Insanely, and against all predictions by cautious engineer types that it was possible, performance cars just keep getting faster and the speed-mad types at Corvette are now promising the latest and greatest version of their storied vehicle. The ZR1X (they were going to call it Zora, but realised that would only appeal to geeky gamer types) will hit 100km/h in less than two seconds. This crazed Corvette combines a thumping twinturbocharged V8 with a front-mounted electric motor, offering a total power output of 1250 horsepower (or 932kW). For comparison, an F1 car must make do with 1000 horsepower. As for price, think \$300,000 plus.
